FINAL JUDGMENT OF DIVORCE

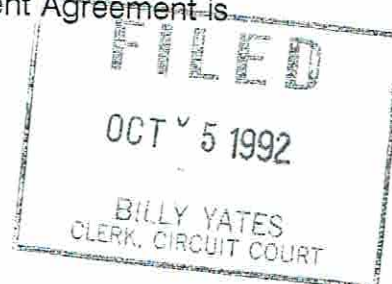
This action, coming on to be heard, was submitted for final judgment upon the pleadings, the Divorce and Property Settlement of the parties, the testimony of the plaintiff, and proof thereof ore tenus. Upon consideration thereof, it is

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. That the bonds of matrimony previously existing between the plaintiff and defendant are hereby dissolved, and that they are forever divorced from each other for and on account of the grounds of a complete incompatibility of temperament.

2. That neither party hereto shall contract marriage, except with each other, until sixty (60) days after the date of this judgment. Should an appeal be taken within forty-two (42) days from the date of this judgment, neither party shall contract marriage, except to each other during the period of appeal.

3. That the Divorce and Property Settlement Agreement entered into by and between the parties is hereby ratified, approved and made a part of this Final Judgment of Divorce in its entirety. A copy of said Divorce and Property Settlement Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated in whole by reference.
