ADDENDUM I
Music Association Scholarship

The scholarship is for those graduating seniors who:

- Have demonstrated exceptional music and/or drama talent.
- Have a cumulative grade point average of 85% or higher in their music classes at the time of application.
- Have been involved in the music program (either as a band or choir member) for all years during their attendance at Millersburg High School through grades 9-12.
- Have been accepted into, and have enrolled in an institution of higher learning. A copy of the college acceptance letter or enrollment confirmation must be attached to the application.
- Remains in good financial standing with the Music Association

Financial need is not a criterion, but planned participation in collegiate musical activities will be considered.

Alumni are not eligible.

If there are no suitable candidates, there will be no scholarship awarded.

Candidates must submit an application for scholarship consideration. This application must be submitted by the deadline established by the Music Directors. This application has been approved by the Millersburg Area Music Association and is attached to this addendum.

The Executive Board will select the scholarship recipient by simple majority vote.

An Executive Board member who is a parent of a student submitting an application shall disqualify himself or herself from the selection process.

The financial award will be in the amount of \$500. This award can be divided amongst equally qualified and deserving applicants at the discretion of the Millersburg Area Music Association. The financial award may be adjusted at the discretion of the MAMA Executive Board.
