

Cleber (Oggún) will be taking 16 people to Cuba on a People to People Exchange. The trip will be February 11-17, 2018 and will be based in Havana.

While you are there, you will have the opportunity to learn about Cuba's agroecology and experience the vibrant culture through history, food, entertainment and new friendships.

Cost will be \$3,000 + \$100 visa + flight to Havana

To apply for a spot, email a short essay to michelle@cleberllc.com by September 1, 2017. The essay should answer the following questions:

- Why do you want to go?
- What you will do with the knowledge/information gained when you return?

Anyone is welcome to apply. Applications will be chosen based on how the applicant believes they can benefit the Cuban people upon their return.

Selections will be made by October 1, 2017. A deposit of \$500 due on November 1 and full payment due on December 1.

Farm Visit #2: Organic Vegetable Cooperative

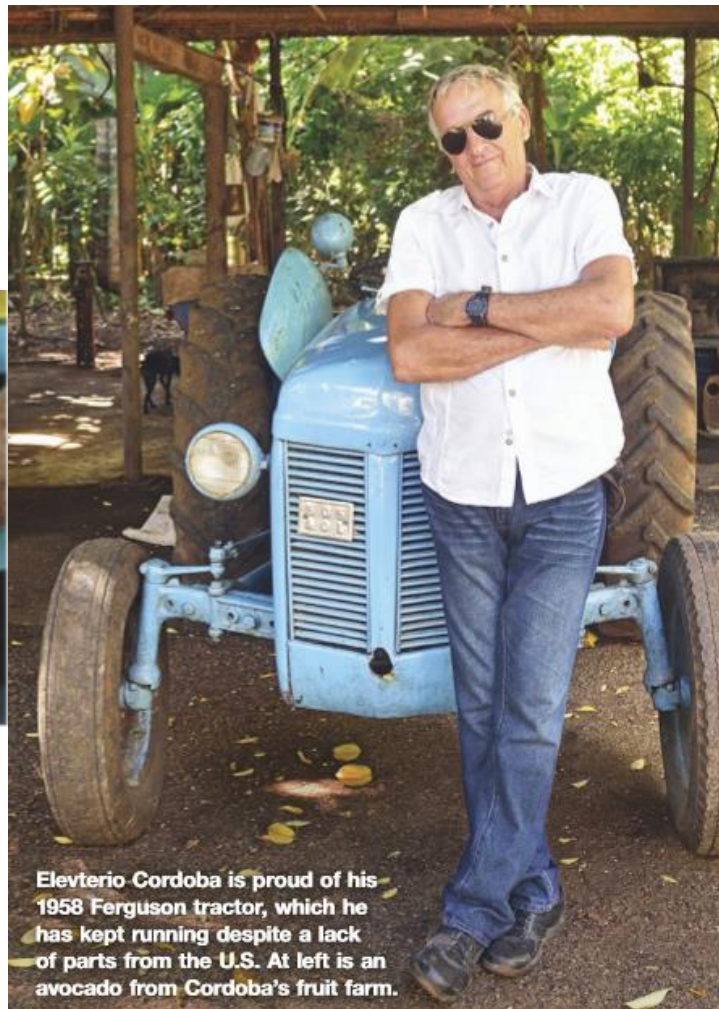
62 acres in Mayabeque Province, 120 employees
