

## **For Bedlington Station Primary School: 2017-18**

**Amount of Primary PE & School Sport Grant: £17,670.00**

**(£16,000.00 plus £10.00 per pupil in years 1-6). NB This represents a doubling of the funding from previous years.**

### **Information to show the Impact the Primary PE Funding is having on:**

1. Bedlington Station Primary School is one of 19 local First/Primary Schools that have pooled all Primary PE Funding to maintain the Blyth & Bedlington School Sport Programme. A service level agreement has been established across not just the Primary sector but also the Secondary schools that the pupils feed into which helps with transition at KS2/3
  
2. **This allows all schools:**
  - Access to a dedicated specialist PE teacher on a weekly basis. These teachers have a family of schools they work with, so a relationship is built up between the school, staff and pupils allowing for more effective teaching.
  - Access to a competition/festival programme of 20 events for pupils in KS1&2 including dance & gymnastics. This is published at the end of the summer term so schools can plan well in advance.
  - Working in partnership with other local schools has allowed for the best use of funding as equipment can be shared and facility hire/transport costs have been negotiated at a much lower rate. Demonstrates best use of funding.
  - Access to an extra-curricular programme of 20 weeks delivery provided by the local sports development unit at a specially negotiated rate. All coaches are 'quality assured' and have appropriate qualifications and clearances. They are all line managed by one person and feedback data is requested at the end of each delivery block.
  - Access to local CPD opportunities
  - A 6 week curriculum delivery block of the FA Soccer Skills programme
  - A single conduit for all external agencies to work through to gain access to schools e.g. Fa/Tesco Soccer Skills programme and Judo programme
  
3. **The PE funding has allowed all year groups to access High Quality PE on a weekly basis.**
  - SSP teacher works in curriculum time with pupils from all year groups on a weekly basis using our equipment bank
  - Bedlington Station Primary School Staff receive weekly CPD by working alongside SSP teacher. All staff gain access to this throughout the year on a rotational ½ term delivery basis.

- This has allowed for a greater range of activities to be taught across KS1&2 e.g. Tag Rugby, athletics, tennis, speed agility & quickness work, multi-skill & physical literacy, where we have provided the equipment to save costs to the school.
- Extra-curricular clubs have been in alternative sports e.g. Street dance, Ultimate Frisbee.

#### 4. Competition entries 2011- 2017:

The figures below show the number of competitions entered and the number of pupil places accessed by Bedlington Station Primary School over the academic years 2011- 2017.

The figures highlight the impact that the Primary PE Funding has had in this area:

<b>2011 – 2012:</b>	0 competitions entered 0 competition places accessed	0 Boys	0 Girls
<b>2012 – 2013:</b>	6 competitions entered 109 competition places accessed	47 Boys	62 Girls
<b>2013 – 2014:</b>	9 competitions entered 155 competition places accessed	74 Boys	81 Girls
<b>2014 – 2015:</b>	10 competitions entered 261 competition places accessed	140 Boys	121 Girls
<b>2015 - 2016:</b>	17 Competitions Entered 344 competition places accessed	179 Boys	165 Girls
<b>2016 – 2017:</b>	15 competitions entered 232 competition places accessed	96 Boys	136 Girls
<b>2017 – 2018:</b>	6 competitions accessed so far (As of 22/12/2017)	53 Boys	70 Girls

#### In the period 2011 – 2017 this shows:

- A **17 Fold** increase in the number of competitions entered by the school prior to 2013
- **32%** increase in the number of pupil places accessed at competitions since 2014-15.

#### 5. Staff professional development:

The school audits staff needs with regards to physical education and uses the school Sport Programme PE teachers to support staff with curriculum delivery in areas they have highlighted.

- In the year prior to the programme starting 3 staff attended external CPD courses.
- In the period 2012 - 2017, 12 staff places were accessed on 9 different external CPD courses

This is additional to the weekly CPD that staff receive in school whilst working alongside SSP teacher

The school is reporting that the high quality PE/competition is impacting on the confidence and self-esteem of pupils as well as having a positive effect on attendance and classroom work.

The quality of the performance of the children from Bedlington Station Primary School has risen dramatically over the past years.

At the gymnastics and dance festivals held annually, the children from Bedlington Station have produced performances of a high technical and creative standard and they are regularly featuring in the top 3 places in competitions.

Since the introduction of the Primary PE & School Sport grant, Bedlington Station Primary School has become a far more active partner within the Blyth & Bedlington School Sport Programme and accesses all events they feel their pupils will benefit from.
