Because of the increased funding now available to schools, we have the opportunity to widen the availability of sports and physical activity provision across the school during 2017-18 and propose to allocate funds in the following areas:

- Engagement with "Cycle Experience" in order to provide a cycling provision for pupils across the school with the accent on ability, safety and physical activity. This will commence with staff training for Balanceability Bikes for Early Years up to Year 1 (free trial already undertaken).

10 x Balance Bikes and associated Training Packs **£900.00**

Staff Training **£250.00**

provide staff with professional development, mentoring, training and resources to help them teach PE and sport more effectively – specifically for Balanceability Bikes. Once trained, staff will be licensed to train other teaching staff including those in the Bedlingtonshire Partnership of Schools in order to widen provision in the area.

Bikeability Training for all Year 4, 5 and 6 pupils for Level 1 and Level 2 at approximately £20.00 per pupil for Year 4 (Years 5 and 6 are already funded) **£600.00**

The establishment on the school site of a bespoke Cycling solution including new bike and scooter storage facility, helmet storage, padlocks and the creation of cycling contracts to be signed by parent, child and school. This will encourage responsible and safe cycling and scootering in the local community and ensure children are able to access this as a means of staying active outside school premises. **£3500.00**

- introduce new sports, dance or other activities to encourage more pupils to take up sport and physical activities. This will include the offer of after school clubs such as Zumba, cricket and Futsal at no cost to children or their families. **£600.00**
- encourage pupils to take on leadership or volunteer roles that support sport and physical activity within the school through extended playtime and lunchtime activities and our Buddy system. This will include embedding physical activity into the school day through active travel to and from school, active playgrounds and active teaching **£500.00**

Sub Total of additional spend £6350.00

Grand Total approximately £16350.00
