

Landfill

Questions and Answers:

Q. What will the landfill accept?

A. Household garbage, appliances free everyday, C& D debris, tires, batteries, and scrap metal.

Q. What is C & D debris?

A. Building materials from construction or demolition projects (including lumber scraps, sheet rock, shingles, wall board, plaster, etc.) must be taken to the Landfill.

Q. What is not accepted at the landfill?

A. No hazardous waste.

Treated wood, railroad ties, and utility poles ARE NOT ACCEPTED.

Q. What E-Waste is accepted at the landfill?

A. Computers

Q. When is "Free Day" at the landfill?

A. Free Day is the second Saturday of April and October.

Q. When is "Household Hazardous Waste Day"?

A. 2 days per year – to be announced.

Q. What material is accepted at the Convenience Sites?

A. Aluminum cans, batteries, cardboard, farmer's oil, glass, magazines, motor oil, motor oil bottles, motor oil filters, newspapers and inserts, office paper, oil/gas mixture, plastic bottles #1 & #2, steel cans, and telephone books. E-Waste, such as computers, TV's, games, radios, etc.
