FAA Requirements

1. FAA Private Pilot Helicopter Certificate
2. FAA Third Class Medical Certificate
3. Pass the FAA Written Exam
4. Obtain 40 hours of Simulated Instrument Time including 15 hours in Helicopters
5. 50 hours of Cross-Country Flight Time as Pilot In Command (10 hours in Helicopters)
6. Pass the FAA oral exam
7. Pass the FAA practical exam
