

Registering for the SummerBASH online Reading Program?

Welcome to Louisburg Library's online SummerBASH Reading Program! We have **NEW** SummerBASH Reading Program Software which manages your online log and awards you fabulous prizes! Take a look around. We have a Welcome tab with several links to SummerBASH fun, a FAQ tab, and a tab for each of the different programs.

There are 4 age groups to choose from: 1) **LISTENERS** (not yet reading on their own), **KIDS** (K-going into 5th grade), **TEENS** (going into 6-12 grade) & **ADULTS** (17 years and up)

You can sign up yourself and/or your household by creating an account. If you are registering multiple family members, start by creating an account just for you. Directions below and on the next page for "I'm registering myself only" and "I'm a parent registering my kids."

"I'm registering myself only"

1. Click the "**Register**" button
 - best to do from the Welcome tab or the tab for the program appropriate for your age
2. Click the "**I'm registering myself only**" button
3. Type your age in the "How old are you?" text box
4. In the drop box click the program that is appropriate for you
5. Click the "**Continue**" button
6. Create your account by filling out the form.
 - An email address is required. If you don't have an email account, call staff for help. 913-837-2217
 - Your username will need to be at least 5 characters.
 - Your password will need to be 7 characters and contain one alpha and one numeric character.
 - You will need to select an **Avatar**, you can change it to a photo of yourself later.
 - Remember to **click** the box to acknowledge that you have read the terms
7. Click the "**Continue**" button
 - if the page does not change, look at the form to see if you forgot to fill something out or if there is some other issue
8. Once you are registered, the program will log you in and it should welcome you with a pop up window letting you know that you have earned a registration badge. Click the "close" button to close that window
9. Starting May 27, you will be able to log your books, pages, minutes, audio books, e-books and hours. This will give you points, which will earn you prizes and can be used by teens & adults to "Get Tickets" in the Raffle for the prize baskets. Teens & Adults can also do *Missions* to earn points. Take some time and look around at all the things you can do on your account.

NEW! EARN POINTS AND WIN PRIZES!

Your eligibility for a prize is determined by racking up points May 27-Aug 4, not by the number of books you read (but the more, the merrier!). Each program is age-based, and each age group has assigned point values. You are not locked into one logging option. Choose what works best for you, and even a combination will work.

LISTENERS: receive a prize for every 100 points, completing the program at 1000 points. 1 Book = 10 points; 1 Hour = 30 points

KIDS: receive a prize for every 100 points, completing the program at 1000 points. 1 Book = 100 points; 1 Hour = 60 points

TEENS & ADULTS: receive a prize at 400 points, 2,000 points, 4,000 points, 10,000 points, and 20,000 points. Raffle tickets for Prize Baskets will be available for every 400 points. Completion of the program occurs at 40,000 points. 1 Book = 400 points; 1 Hour = 100 points

“I’m a parent registering my kids”

1. Click the “**Register**” button
 - best to do from the Welcome tab
2. Click the “**I’m a parent registering my kids**” button
3. First the program will ask about you.
4. Type **your age** in the “How old are you?” text box
5. In the drop box click the program that is appropriate for **you**, even if you are not participating.
6. There is a question asking if you intend to actively participate in the Adult program. Whether you participate or not, you will be asked to fill out a form about yourself to create an account.
Click “**Yes**” or “**No**”
7. Then click “**Continue**”
8. Create your account by filling out the form.
 - An email address is required. If you don’t have an email account, call staff for help. 913-837-2217
 - Your username will need to be at least 5 characters.
 - Your password will need to be 7 characters and contain one alpha and one numeric character.
 - You will need to select an **Avatar**, you can change it to a photo of yourself later.
 - Remember to **click** the box to acknowledge that you have read the terms
9. Click the “**Continue**” button
 - if the page does not change, look at the form to see if you forgot to fill something out or if there is some other issue
10. The program will automatically start asking you about your child. In the drop box select the appropriate program for your child. Fill in the text box with your child’s age.
 - If you have more than one child, you will have to repeat this step and the following steps for each child.
11. Click “**Continue Adding This Child**”
12. Create your child’s account by filling out the form.
 - the username must be original, but the password can be the same as your account
 - the program is offering a book recommendation service. If you turn this on, you will be asked about your child’s reading preferences.
13. Once the form is filled out either click on “**Done Adding Children**” or “**Continue**” if you have more kids to register
 - to register more kids repeat steps 10-13 until you click “Done Adding Children”
14. Once you are registered, the program will log you in and it should welcome you with a pop up window letting you know that you have earned a registration badge. Click the “close” button to close that window
15. If you are not participating you will see a page that lists all of the accounts you created. To visit another account click the “Go to Account”  button to the right of the persons account. You will be able to switch accounts from this page and by using the “**Family Accounts**” drop box on the right hand side of the participating accounts. 
16. If you are participating you will be able to switch between all of the accounts you created and are managing by using the “**Family Accounts**” drop down box on the right hand side of your window.
17. Starting May 27, you will be able to log your family’s books, minutes, and more. Logging for the different accounts, will earn prizes on the accounts and can be used by teens & adults to “Get Tickets” in the Raffle for the prize baskets. Teens & Adults can also do *Missions* to earn points. Take some time and look around at all the things you can do on all of the accounts.

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
