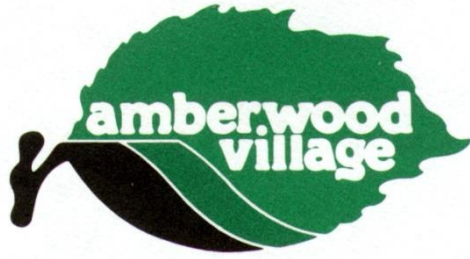


Assistant Golf Course Superintendent
